The pinnacle of Raleigh convenience is the Bishops Park location within easy walking distance to Cameron Village, Five Points and Glenwood South.



Threatened by plans for an upscale shopping center, the roughly 60 acre Methodist Orphanage site instead became an urban live-work-play oasis in the 1980s. This is the old A. J. Fletcher family home that overlooks the Orphanage site.



Fred Fletcher City Park is part of the old Orphanage site. It includes a water garden, athletic fields, tennis courts, amphitheater and rolling hills.



Several blocks west is Cameron Village. One of the first shopping centers in the South, the Village has evolved gracefully over the years, now home to many restaurants, public library and much more. NC State is nearby.



Five Points, a short walk north, includes the Rialto movie theater, restaurants, coffee shops, all surrounded by 4 historic districts including the stately Hayes Barton neighborhood.



The Glenwood South entertainment district, three blocks to the south, includes an adaptably reused dairy building and lots new including condos and a hotel. State government offices and museums border the district to the east.
