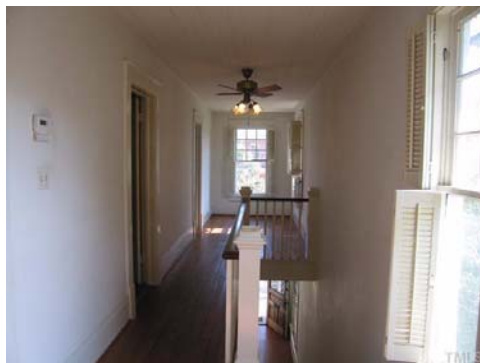
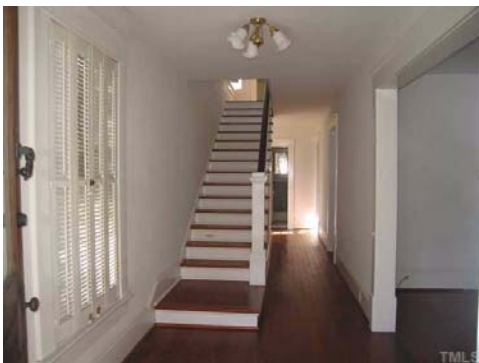

Double porches in back are a more recent addition. The porches need repair, as does much of the rest of the house. A Steve Smallman inspection report is available upon request.

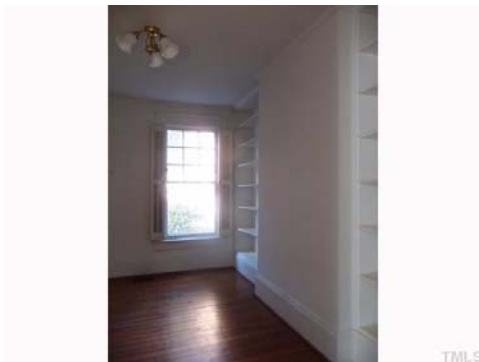
Ah, but it is a jewel, with lots light , 6-over-1 shuttered windows, decorative fireplaces and a versatile floor plan.
