



Upstairs again, the hall leads past the three bedrooms to a full bath. There are options for adding a 2nd upstairs bath to create a true master suite. A floor plan is available.



One MBR option is to use the back most laundry room as a master bath and closet. It already opens to the back bedroom and porch. Apparently once a second kitchen, it most recently was part of a two room workshop.
