



A slate-tiled, windowed hall leads to the back porch and deck from the kitchen. Offering a 2nd access to the back bath, It doubles as a mud room and laundry conveniently located by the back door.



The master suite in the middle of the house has a large walk in closet and original hardwood floors. Window blinds throughout the house are double cellular top down bottom up blinds offering optimal privacy, extra insulation and natural light.



The unique large walk in master shower has a pebble stoned floor, tiled seating and large shower ledge with built in planter.
