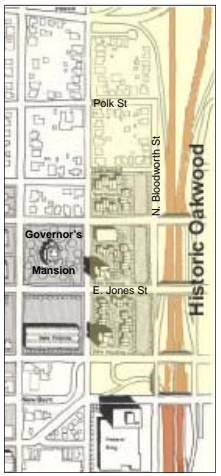
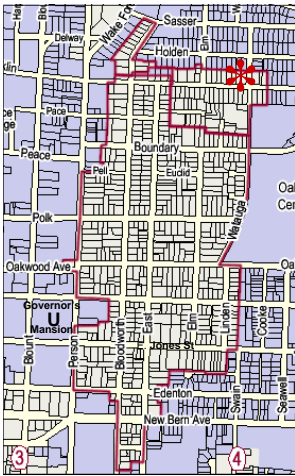
Walk to work, museums, galleries,

Nearby restaurants include PieBird around the corner, Tyler's Taproom, 18 Seaboard, Seaboard Café, J. Betski's, Side Street, Sunflower's Café, Peace China. Grab a sandwich and old fashioned vanilla coke at the Person Street Pharmacy. Family friendly Friday night concerts are a neighborhood gathering place on the lawn of the Mordecai Historic House and Park (I) a couple of blocks away. This is a happening place.

Overlapping local and national Oakwood historic districts are shown in the map (below left). Go to www.RHDC.org for detailed maps and Historic District guidelines and procedures. While located just outside the boundary of the non-profit Oakwood community association which matches the local historic district, many neighbors participate in Oakwood activities that include a 4th of July parade and picnic and holiday Candlelight Tour.
