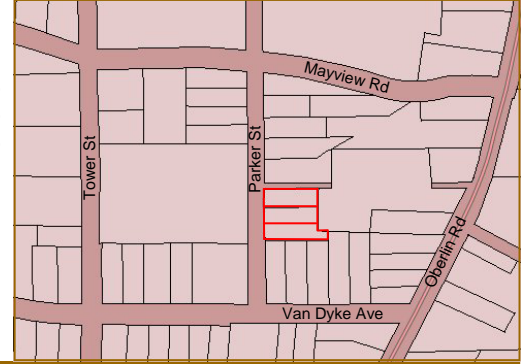

*Be a part of history.*

Build your own dream home on one of these three level lots (left). Walk to Cameron Village, NC State University, the newly opened Shoppes at Oberlin Court, the Raleigh Little Theatre, the main public library. The lots are located in the historic Oberlin neighborhood, named after Oberlin College in Ohio. The "Oberlin Village" was formed after the Civil War with homes, churches, businesses and schools, including one of the first publically supported Raleigh schools in 1877.



Looking west across Parker St is a two acre park (right), the site of the former Rev. M. L. Latta House that was listed on the National Register of Historic Places and designated a Raleigh Historic Landmark until it was destroyed by fire in 2007. The park is the remaining land area of Latta University founded in 1892 and closed in the 1920's. Results of a recent archaeological survey will be used to determine if the site, recently donated to the City, can be reinstated as a Raleigh Historic Landmark. Though the Oberlin neighborhood is neither a local or national historic district, efforts to preserve some of its heritage have resulted in several other structures being designated Raleigh Historic Landmarks in the area that stretches from Clark Ave north past Wade Ave.



Today the Village is a mix of new and old homes, including those shown here that surround Latta Park. Three of these are nearby neighbors on Parker St.



\* Steve Jellicorse with MorningStar Homes, Inc., is available to discuss building options for the three lots on which were located two cinder block apartments demolished in 2008. Options include building one or more of the three homes (see elevation below) that were sensitively designed for the site by David Maurer Architecture. The price of a completed home at 912 Parker Street would begin at \$450,000. MorningStar is the only builder in the Triangle area that is had been accepted into the Southern Living (Magazine) Custom Builder Program.
