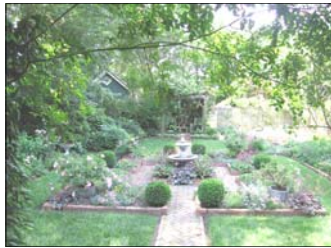

Inspired in 1995 by a nearby Historic Oakwood home, c.1900, Jim and Sharon Bright built the *Rose Cottage* on the site of a duplex that was lost to fire in 1973. Later they enlarged the yard to its current size of 0.2 acres, adding the large garden cottage / studio pictured below.

Built as a gathering place for their 10 grandchildren, the "not so big house" has a versatile floor plan, the gardens have enchanting hideaways. Collaborating with former Oakwood neighbor and architect Janet Wellman, the Brights realized their dream house with its timeless tiled fireplaces, transom windows, wide center hall, high ceilings, spacious front porch, custom cabinets, wood stove, cedar siding. The recycled heart pine floors once were part of the old Sears building in Chicago.

The *parterre* style garden has patterned flower beds & brick herring-bone paths. The focal point is a four-square garden centered on a two-tier fountain. Various vines, roses & wisteria wind around two trellises, a pergola and the big front & smaller back porches. A "secret garden" is hidden away in back near where the Brights grow vegetables and relax.
