

The neighborhood

Mordecai, Oakdale, Meadowbrook, Oakwood area all are names used, with varying degrees of accuracy, to describe the location of the property east of Wake Forest Rd, west and south of Brookside Dr and north of Historic Oakwood (which is bordered by Franklin St to the north). While originally part of the Mordecai plantation, it is not included in the Mordecai National Historic District, highlighted in blue below. The immediate neighborhood was subdivided in the late 1940's, its Meadowbrook name perhaps derived from the prior use of the land and the nearby creek running along Brookside Dr. Learn more and/or add info at:
