New kitchen

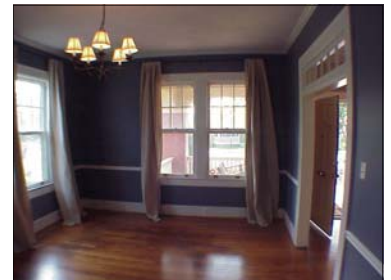
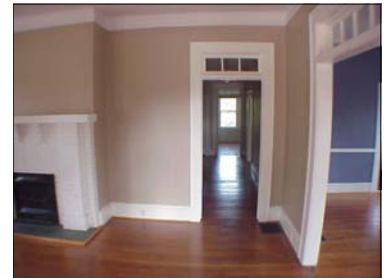

The large 17x13ft dining room also opens into the kitchen. A daylight laundry and utility room lead from the kitchen to the back deck. The fireplace is decorative.

Walk-up attic.

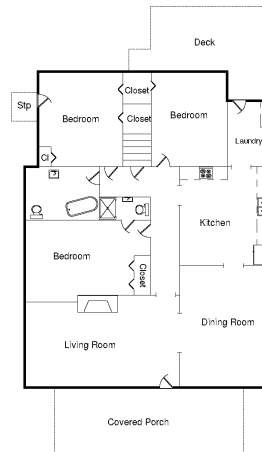
A large deck overlooks the fenced back yard that offers great gardening options. A partial walk-in basement is accessed from a door under the deck. The addition of a cement floor could make this a versatile basement workshop. The bright walk-up attic (pictured below) has been partially framed for future expansion.

The back corner bedroom could be a home office with an outside entrance that opens into the fenced side/backyard and is accessible from the driveway on the south side of the lot. This bedroom has 3 closets one of which is shared with the other back bedroom.

The main bath has handsome tile, a pedestal sink and a tip-toe bathtub with a shower ring. The "master" bedroom has a double closet & a compact bathroom.
