Mordecai is a family friendly eclectic neighborhood of tree and Bungalow lined streets located a short distance from downtown. This is a primary reason news homes have been built surrounding Mordecai. The Mordecai historic neighborhood was named for the family plantation on which it was developed. The Mordecai House (I) still survives in the area and is the centerpiece of the neighborhood and the nucleus of Mordecai Historic Park.

Because Mordecai is a National Register Historic District, certified renovations are eligible for NC Historic Rehab Tax Credit. Since it not a locally designated district, exterior changes are not subject to design review by the Raleigh Historic Development Commission. Learn more and/or add info at:
