



Earlier, Fallon Florist used this site for their nursery & greenhouses, conveniently locating them across the street from the Oakwood Cemetery.

The sellers built this home, tailoring it to meet their family needs and to provide space for their quilting craft. The versatile floor plan with 4 bedrooms (2 up, 2 down) and a large bonus loft space up offer multiple options for office, den, studio, nursery, rec room.


