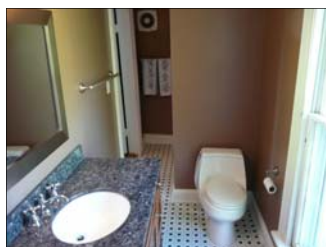
a window in a stone addition to this half are 2 full baths, eled with tile floors years.
