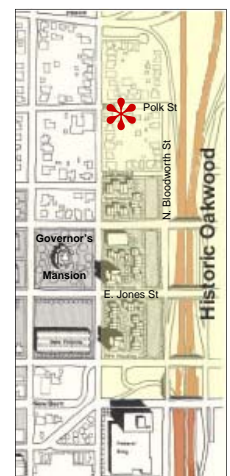
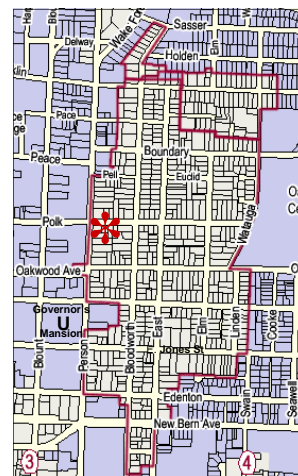

Family friendly Friday night concerts are a neighborhood gathering place on the lawn of the Mordecai Historic House and Park (I) a couple of blocks away. This is a happening place.
